Approximately 10,000 students are divided between the regional universities. They have made their mark through applied research and education, as well as through numerous prizes and awards. Endowed professorships and research projects contribute to a tight integration with the business world.

The sports clubs in Ostwuerttemberg offer more than 60 different kinds of sports plus their rich club activities. Most of the amateur trainers help people of all ages and skill levels to do sports in their free time.

#### Innovative industries in Ostwuerttemberg

The Ostwuerttemberg region is characterized both by traditional sectors (such as machine construction) and by the high-tech field (such as photonics and surface engineering). The areas of competence of the region of Ostwuerttemberg are the following:

#### Photonic

The high-tech sector of photonics developed from the traditional optics sector. In "Photonic Valley" in Ostwuerttemberg the entire value-added chain from development to production to supplier service is covered.

#### Surface technologies

Ostwuerttemberg looks back on an age-long tradition of surface treatment. Today, Ostwuerttemberg is an important center of competence within the industry and is home to numerous well-known and globally active research and transfer institutions, associations, businesses as well as, education and training institutions.

#### Automotive

With its longstanding tradition in the fields of metal working and machining, Ostwuerttemberg has developed into a region with a high level of automotive competence. There are more than 200 enterprises in the automotive sector that provide more than 30,000 jobs.

#### Machine-, Plant- and Tool-building Industry

Originating from a long tradition of metalworking, today's machine-, plant- and toolbuilding industry comprises at least 300 business companies, making it one of the industries with the highest sales volume in the region.









#### Forestry, lumber and paper

Another characteristic of the Ostwuerttemberg region is a large spectrum of lumber processing and woodworking, ranging from traditional forestry and lumber processing to modern tool- and machine-building companies focusing on lumber and wood. As many as 700 businesses employ a total of approximately 9,000 people.

#### Energy

The energy sector has developed strongly in Ostwuerttemberg in recent years. With around 150 companies, the region offers great potential across the entire valueadded chain. Furthermore, the regional universities and research institutions are fueling the knowledge in this future-oriented industry whose main focus is on renewable energies.

#### **Culture and creative industries**

Ostwuerttemberg stands for high cultural and creative competence, based on a multitude of design offices, advertising agencies, architects, artists and innovative software companies. Well over 2,000 companies and players constitute this field of competence. Numerous educational institutions, transfer centers and associations form the basis for success.

#### Logistics

As Ostwuerttemberg is an industrial and production location, logistics is a crosssectional industry of great importance for the region. With over 400 companies and approximately 15,000 employees, the logistics sector is well positioned here. The region's geographical location and its direct connection to the A7 motorway play an important role for transportation.


## Active Economic Development for Ostwuerttemberg
