
conditions for businesses and skilled professionals.

CORE COMPETENCIES OF THE REGION

PHOTONICS AND OPTICAL TECHNOLOGIES

Around 60 companies, led by Carl Zeiss, cover the entire value chain.

SURFACE TECHNOLOGY

A key competence center where tradition meets high-tech.

AUTOMOTIVE

Over 200 companies with more than 30,000 jobs are direct or indirect suppliers to the automotive industry.

MACHINERY. PLANT AND TOOL ENGINEERING

With at least 300 companies, this is one of the region's highest revenue industries.

FORESTRY — WOOD — PAPER

Around 9,500 employees work in this cluster across approximately 700 companies, ranging from small craft businesses to global players. Forests cover 42% of the region's area.






